### **DECISIONS OF THE MEETING OF THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE HELD ON 12TH MAY, 2026 ON THE PROTEST AND INCIDENTS THAT OCCURRED DURING AND AFTER THE MATCH BETWEEN MBBS FOOTBALL TEAM AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SCIENCE (EHS) FOOTBALL TEAM**

#### **FINDINGS:**

1. That the referee added three (3) minutes additional time and properly indicated the same before the end of regulation time as against the alleged 17 minutes.
2. That the protested goal was scored at exactly the 63rd minute of play and no foul or infringement occurred before the goal was scored.
3. That Article 17 of the FUHSI VC's Games Bye-Law states that the referee's decision on matters within the field of play shall be final.
4. That Player No. 10 of the Environmental Health Science (EHS) football team displayed dissent by word toward the referee after the match and was consequently issued a red card.
5. That members of the EHS team, bench, and supporters invaded the field of play after the match.
6. That during the invasion, an ash-colored Crocs belonging to one of the match officials got missing.
7. That Article 16 of the Bye-Law provides that a player issued a red card shall pay a fine of ₱2,000.
8. That Article 3 of the Bye-Law holds departments accountable for the conduct of their supporters before, during, and after matches.

## **DECISIONS**

Based on the above findings, the Committee decides as follows:

1. That the protest submitted by the Environmental Health Science (EHS) football team hereby fails.
2. That the result of the match shall stand as played and the goal scored in added time remains valid.
3. That Player No. 10 of the Environmental Health Science (EHS) football team shall pay the sum of Two Thousand Naira (**₦2,000**) for the red card issued for dissent toward the referee.
4. That the Environmental Health Science (EHS) football team shall pay the sum of Five Thousand Naira (**₦5,000**) for invading the field of play and for violating the Bye-Law regarding the finality of the referee's decision.
5. That the missing ash-colored Crocs belonging to the match official must be provided within twenty-four (24) hours from the issuance of this decision, failing which further sanctions shall be imposed on the team.

The Committee further warns all teams, officials, supporters, and participants to conduct themselves in a peaceful and orderly manner before, during, and after matches. Acts capable of intimidating officials, disrupting games, or bringing the competition into disrepute will not be tolerated.

The Committee remains committed to ensuring discipline, fairness, transparency, and the smooth conduct of sporting activities within the institution.
